The Class of 1974 was able to celebrate their 50th class reunion this weekend as well. Thanks to Rick Giovanetto for this photo and names!






Learn one surprising reason that you experience stress in your life and how it affects your overall health -- physical, mental, and emotional.

Start seeing farmers! Farmers in our area have been working tirelessly over the past few weeks to get their harvests in, and keeping them safe is key. This article from the Illinois Farm Bureau gives lots of info for rural road safety, but a few key tips are:

- Above all, slow down and be patient.
- Reduce speed when encountering farm equipment on public roads. Flashing amber lights mean "caution."
- Keep a safe distance from the farm equipment so farmers can see you. If you can't see their mirrors, they can't see you.
