Middle School Career Programming





This year, the Illinois Postsecondary and Career Expectations (PaCE) Framework is a new program at Tremont Middle School, designed to help middle and early high school students explore their future options. This program gives students structured opportunities to learn about college and career paths in a way that suits their age and development. The goal is to make college and career feel possible and within reach for all students—not just those who already see themselves going that direction. By starting this exploration in middle school, students can build a foundation for more in-depth planning in high school, promoting a positive, growth-focused mindset about their future education and careers.





Eighth-grade students from Tremont Middle School were able to participate in the annual Greater Peoria CareerSpark event at the Civic Center. Prior to the event, they completed career surveys to reflect on their personal strengths and weaknesses. In class, teachers discussed the importance of understanding one's interests and talents when planning for a future career. During the event, students were introduced to a variety of careers by companies from the Greater Peoria area. The center was organized into career clusters, featuring a wide range of interactive activities designed to help students explore skills related to different jobs. Students enjoyed stations involving the fingerprinting process, dissection of a pig's heart, and participation in a mock classroom, among others. After returning from the trip, students set goals and researched educational pathways. The 8th-grade team looks forward to attending again next year, as the event provides an invaluable educational experience for everyone involved.

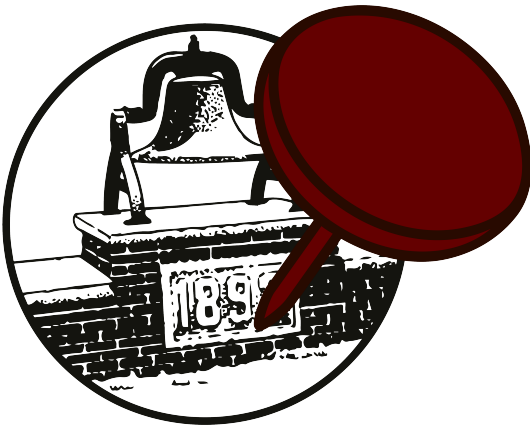
