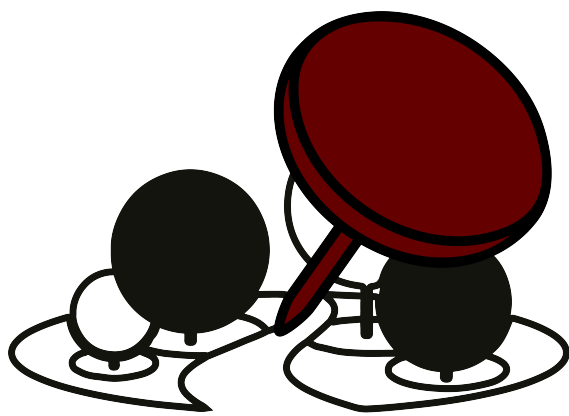

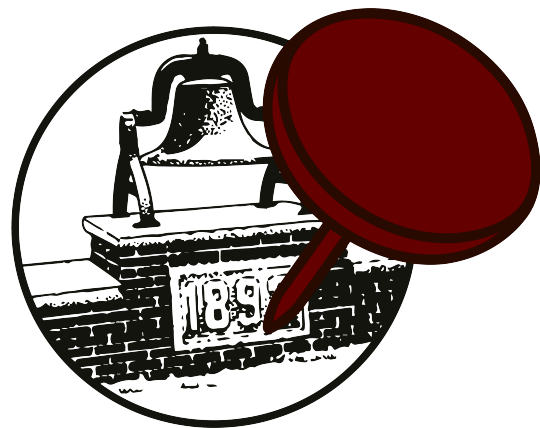

Tremont's New Gymnasium

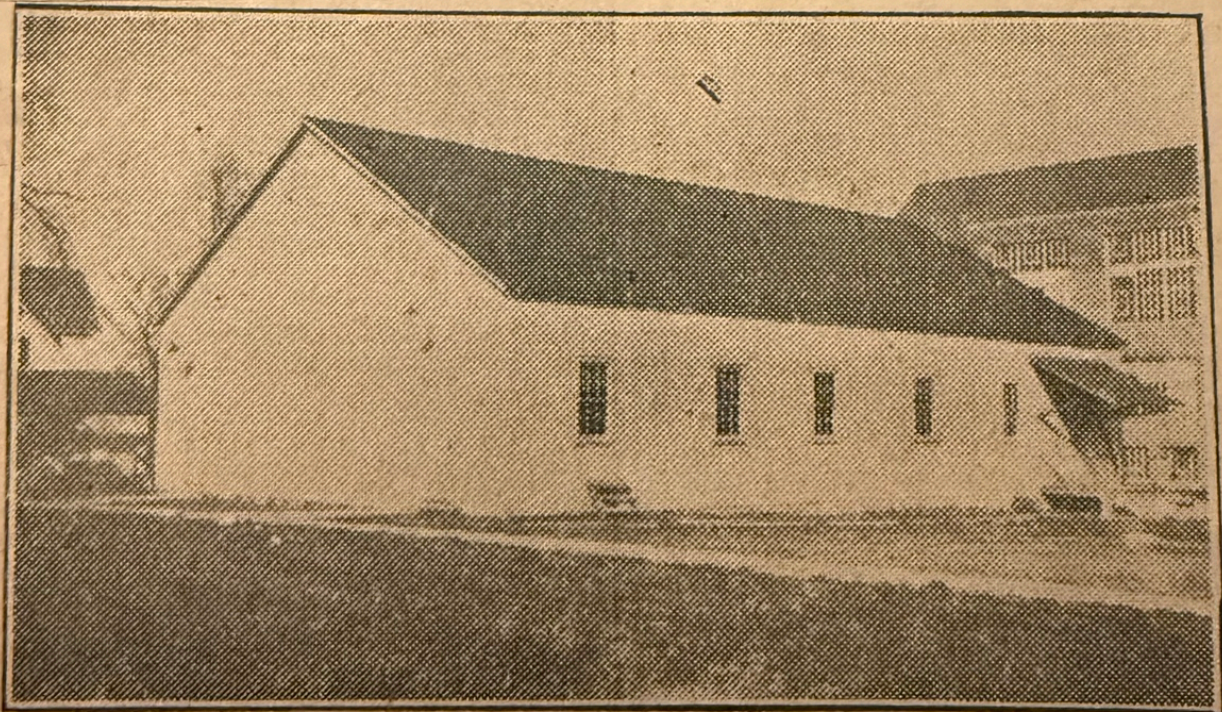
An undated article details the town's excitement over a new community gymnasium. The gymnasium was built on the grounds of Tremont Community High School, which was located behind the current grade school, facing Harris Street.

About three years before, the need for a gymnasium was "keenly felt, as the article states. The story of how the gymnasium building came to be is an unusual one.

Principal at the time was J.H. Johnson. He worked with the boys of the high school to come up with the building plan. The boys approached the school board and requested \$1,000, which they would repay out of their summer wages.

Once members of the community heard of this plan, Tremont business men donated \$500. The students were able to contribute \$700 from their summer jobs. In the end, the board did not expect the students to repay the remaining amount.

**New Gymnasium on Grounds of Tremont Community High School.
Boys of the School Gave Summer Earnings to Help Pay for It.**

The resulting building, built around 1923, was 46 by 70 feet with a stage 12 by 70 feet, and a balcony around the interior of the building providing more space for spectators. The gym was used for for high school games, banquets, dances, and other community events, but later burned down.

Once again, high school boys were involved in building a new gymnasium by physically helping with the excavation. The new gym was almost twice the size of the old one, with sideline seating for 500, and space for 100 more on the stage. The new gym was dedicated in December of 1933.
