


“Local Happenings” and Other News From The Tremont News – 1925

Last week’s article explored some of the ads in a typical Tremont News newspaper a century ago. The ads provide a fascinating peek into life in Tremont at the time, when dresses could be purchased for \$1.00, and people needed to plan ahead to purchase coal, or to have their plowshares sharpened before the spring planting rush. And a local restaurant needed two good cows to butcher!

In those same 1925 newspapers, there are several short articles that give more insight into daily life in those days.

9,500,000 Cars in the U.S.


25 years ago there were 14,000 automobiles in the United States. This year the automobile industry is celebrating its Silver Jubilee and there are over 9,500,000 cars in the hands of

owners... the growth in this industry is nothing short of appalling.

"The reasonable inference is that the horse must be a victim of this relentless progress of mechanical civilization... Pictures of Bloomington or any other city 25 years ago indicate that once upon a time the horse occupied a much more important place in our daily life than it does now. Few indeed are the horses on our crowded thoroughfares...


