- 2–3 for 12U+ (1 out of town)

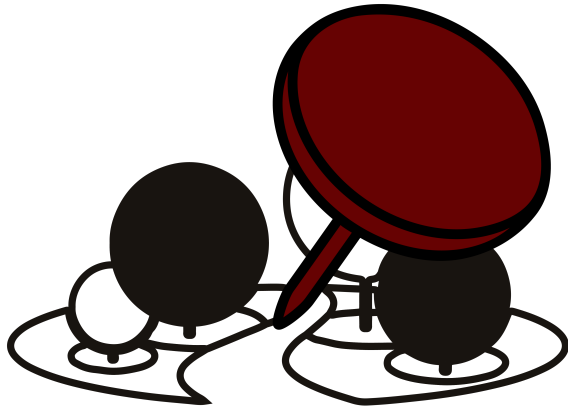

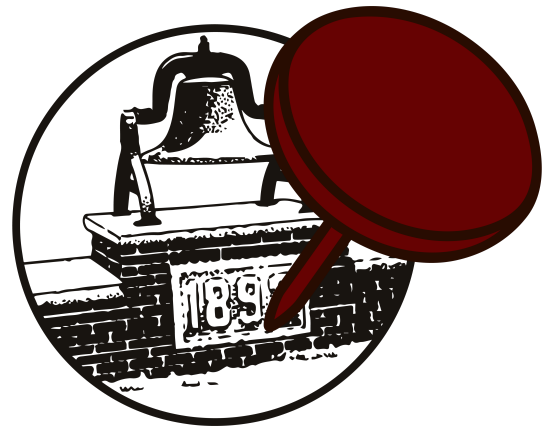


Village of Tremont

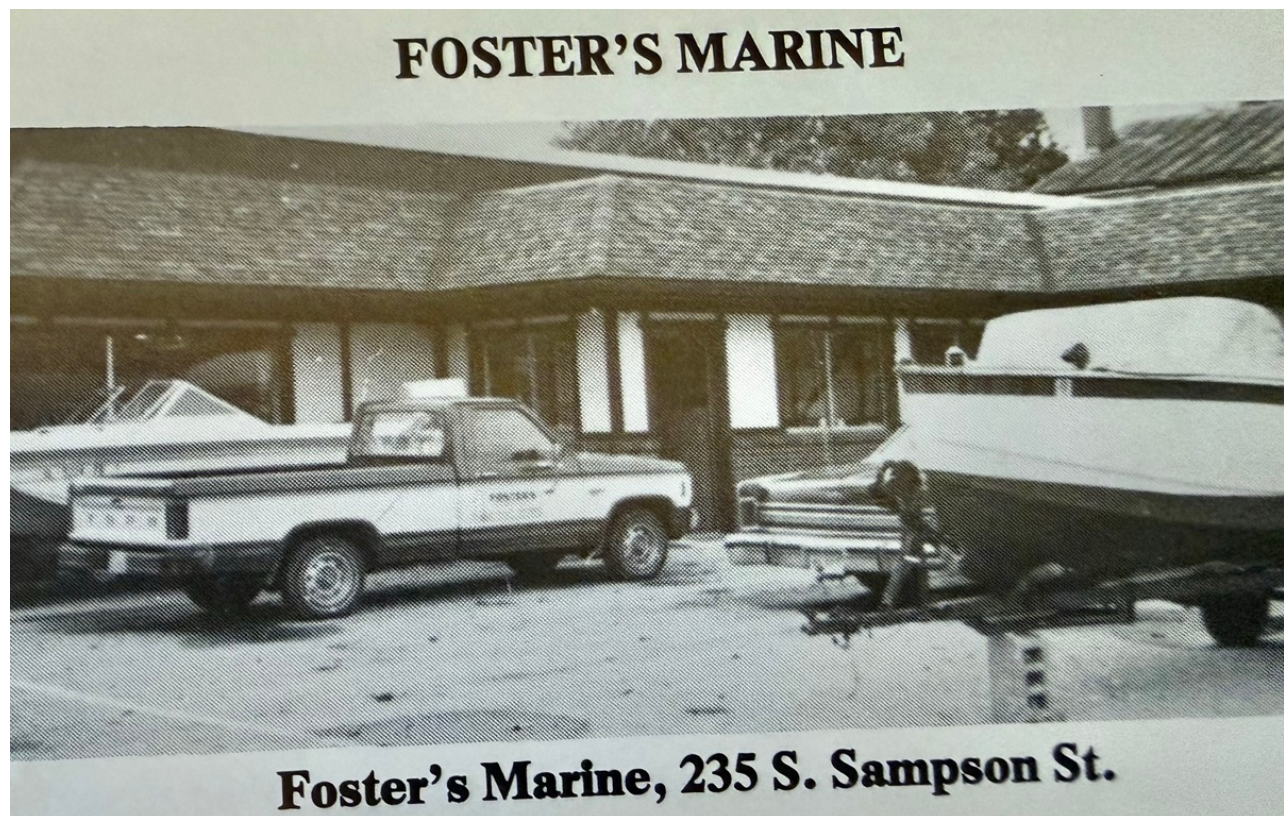

Tremont's Unusual Businesses

At various times in the past, Tremont has had some unusual businesses.

Among the typical hardware, drug, and grocery stores, the bakeries and saloons, the blacksmiths and liverys, implement businesses and jewelry stores, garages, banks and insurance companies, etc., there were also businesses in town for:

- noodle making
 - feather cleaning
 - auto curtains
 - poultry
 - taxidermy
 - duck blinds
 - boat storage
- ...and a houseboat factory!



Also, did you know...

In the 1930s, all kinds of stores in Tremont and elsewhere had slot machines – nickel, dimes, and quarters. The State's Attorney got a cut. A new states attorney said what they were doing was illegal. Local tavern owners were upset.

On Saturday nights everyone came to town for shopping.
